Saints of the Week

St Charles Borromeo Leo The Great became Pope in 440 AD. He is remembered for defending the Church from the Barbarians.

St Martin de Tours was born in Hungary but became a disciple of St Hilary of Poitiers. He was Bishop of Tours and was the first non-martyr in the church's calendar. He is a patron of Priests.

St Josaphat was born in Ukraine in 1550. He followed the Byzantine Rite but worked to unite the church. He was martyred in 1623.
