TRINITY SUNDAY is the first Sunday after Pentecost and honours the Holy Trinity the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. While the word "Trinity" does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 along with many other Bible passages.

The Bible tells us, *"And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit' (Matthew 28:18-20).*

The concept of the Holy Trinity can never be completely understood. That is them. mystery. But it is clearly taught in Scripture.

Understanding this comes through the work of the Holy Spirit; therefore, it is appropriate that this mystery is celebrated the first Sunday after Pentecost, when the outpouring of the Holy Spirit first occurred.
